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GENERAL OVERVIEW

The 2025 Annual Budget Law of the Republic of Armenia involves – AMD 2,837.6 bln revenues, AMD 3,441.6 bln expenditures and a deficit equaling to AMD 604 bln, or 26%, 30.5% and 5.5% of the GDP respectively.

Expenditures on the social protection in the Annual Budget are presented under the social protection programmes, which is coordinated by the RA Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs (MLSA).


According to the explanatory note of the RA Government for 2025, the main objectives of social protection are: significantly reduction of the poverty level, improving demographic situation and providing social guarantees to the certain population groups in the Republic of Armenia.

In 2025, it is planned to allocate AMD 905.6 bln to the Social Protection Sector, which is 26.3 % of the total state budget expenditures and 8.3 % of GDP. Funding for the Social Protection Sector has increased by 6.2 % compared to the previous year.

Share of Social Protection in budget expenditures in 2025, %


- 2025, social protection expenditures dominate in the total state budget expenditures.
- It is planned to allocate AMD 905.6 bln to the Social Protection Sector in 2025, which is 26.3 % of total budget expenditures.


Budget for the Social Protection programmes and its annual growth (%) in 2020-2025

- The programme funding in 2025 shall increase by 6.2 % compared with the previous year and amount to AMD 905,6 bln.
- The funding for the Social Protection is growing. In the average annual growth in volumes of finding for 2020-2025 will be 9,7 %. As a result, the 2025 level will exceed the level of 2020 by about 1.7 times, or by AMD 357.3 bln.
- The largest increase was recorded in 2024, at 20.8%, compared to 2023. A low growth rate of 1% was recorded in 2022, compared to 2021.




SOCIAL PROTECTION BUDGET SHARE IN TOTAL BUDGET EXPENDITURES

Social Protection Budget share in Total Budget Expenditures, 2020-2025, %



- Allocations to the Social Protection Sector in 2024 will amount to 26.3 %, which is lower by 2.5 percentage points compared to the previous year.
- The share of Social Protection sector expenditure in budget expenditure in 2025 is lower compared to all previous five years. The average level of the social protection budget/budget expenditure ratio was 28.3 %.
- The average annual growth rate in social protection expenditure is lower than the corresponding indicator in the state budget. The average annual growth of the total expenses of the state budget in 2021-2025 was 10.6 %, with a 9.7 percent level of the social protection budget.

Share of the Social Protection Programme Budget in GDP, 2020-2025, %



- The social protection budget for 2025 will amount to 8.3 % of the GDP, which is 0.1 percentage points higher than the level of the previous year.
- The share of social protection expenditure in GDP in 2025 is lower than in all the previous five years. During the 2020-2025, the average level of the Social Protection Expenditure/GDP ratio was 8.2 %.



SOCIAL PROTECTION BUDGET STRUCTURE BY PROGRAMMES

- The largest budget programme in the Social Protection sector is the Pension Security Programme to which 62% of budget is allocated.
- Budget programmes Social Security and Improving Demographic Situation (IDS) follow with shares of 14%, and 9% respectively.
- In total, the 3 (three) largest programmes ensure 85% of the Social Protection budget. The remaining 15 percent is provided through other programs, such as: Support for Vulnerable social groups and support for social groups in difficult life situations, Social support for temporary incapacity, Employment, Housing, Social support to individual social groups to resist crises situations, and to reduce and eliminate the consequences of emergency situation and other programmes.






















